



## 2022-23 Supply Lists

We encourage students to re-use school supplies that they have from past years.

### ALL STUDENTS (Kindergarten – 12th grade)

- School Bag
- Lunch Box/Bag
- Water bottle (Reusable flip-top)
- 2 Large Pink Erasers
- 1 package pencil cap erasers
- 1 – 4 oz. bottle of school glue (Make sure the “AP” symbol is on the bottle.)
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 packages of 4-color dry erase markers (Make sure the “AP” symbol is on the package.)
- Bible. **KJV** Version– which parallels our curriculum.
- 1 solid color sweater or sweatshirt (NO HOOD) to be kept at school for indoor use from Oct. 15 – April 30.
- 1 – 12” ruler showing inches and centimeters
- 1 **green**, hard-plastic, two pocket folder (daily take home folder)
- 1 **blue**, hard-plastic, two pocket folder (for at school work to be completed)
- 1 **red**, hard-plastic folder (to be kept at school)
- 1 pair Fiskar (or good quality scissors (Labeled with student name)
- 1 package **Classic** color markers (Make sure “AP” symbol is on the marker package.)
- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 2 canisters of Clorox Wipes
- 4 boxes of Kleenex (or generic brand)
- 4 packages loose leaf, wide-rule notebook paper
- 2 highlight markers (Make sure “AP” symbol is on the package.)
- 1 package colored pencils
- 2 black Sharpie markers (one thin, one thick)
  
- **Optional:** Bible cover and Bible highlighter

## **KINDERGARTEN – 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade**

- 2 packages Ticonderoga Pencils, sharpened  
Kindergarten: large Ticonderoga pencils  
Grades 1-3 Regular Ticonderoga pencils – available at Staples
- 2 plastic school supply boxes (red and blue)
- 2 zippered pencil bags to hold markers
- 4 boxes of Crayola crayons – 24 count
- 1 box - 2 gallon or larger Ziploc bags (or generic brand)
- 1 box – sandwich sized plastic bags
- Additional for **2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade**
  - 2 pens (blue or black)
  - 4 package loose-leaf note-book paper
  - 3 packages 100 count 3x5 white, lined index cards

- 1 computer flash drive (for saving documents)
- 4 packages loose leaf, wide-rule notebook paper
- 4 pens (blue or black)
- 1 package graph paper
- 2 package Ticonderoga pencils
- 1 plastic supply box (to hold crayons)
- 3 pencil bags to hold markers, scissors, pens
- 4 boxes Crayola crayons – 24 count
- 1 box gallon Ziploc bags
- 4 packages (100 count) 3x5 white, lined index cards
- 1 loose-leaf notebook
- 1 package tabbed notebook dividers
- 1 protractor

## **Grades 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>**

- 1 protractor
- 1 compass
- 1 package of graph paper
- 1 computer flash drive (for saving documents)
- 1 calculator (optional)
- 7 – hard plastic two pocket folders - one for each subject (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, and black) These are in addition to the green take-home folder for all Summit students.
- 4 – pencil pouches (different colors) to hold pencils/erasers, pens, and markers
- 2 box crayons – 24 count
- 4 packages (100 count) white, lined 3"x5" index cards
- 2 package pencils (sharpened) – Replenish as necessary
- 4 pens (blue or black)
